Sets: Big on Christmas; Snowfall

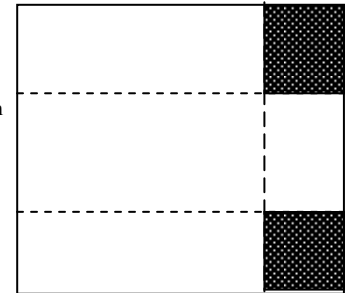
Accessories: Bashful Blue ink & cardstock,

Whisper White ink, Stampin' Write markers:

Bashful Blue, Only Orange, Real Red,

Mellow Moss; White grosgrain ribbon, Rectangle punch

7 ½ inches scored at 6 inches



8 ½ inches scored at
3 and 6 inches, bottom
flap is 2 ½ inches



- The white cardstock was pre-cut & pre-scored to the following dimensions: 7 ½ x 8 ½ and scored on the 7 ½ side at 6 inches, turn and score on the 8 ½ side at 3 inches & 6 inches and the remaining panel is 2 ½ inches (this panel is the bottom panel that will fold up).



- Stamp the white cardstock with the snowflakes in Bashful Blue on the “back side” and then cut out the top and bottom square area. The middle flap folds in and you punch two holes and thread the grosgrain ribbon to form a pocket. The excess ribbon is long enough to tie closed the closed, folded enclosure. Stamp the greetings inside next to the pocket.
- On the small pre-cut white rectangle, stamp the “Let It Snow” in black and then color it in as shown. Adhere it to the Bashful Blue rectangle and adhere

to the back of the top panel as shown with the decorative fiber (JoAnn Fabrics knitting yarn) tied around.
