

## Instructions




 Die-cut shapes three times from material of choice (heavy cardstock is recommended). Three cuts will yield six hexagons, three of the hexagons will not be needed.




 Attach a hexagon with a hole in it to your project base with a brad so that the base will spin. Apply strong double-sided tape to top of hexagon.




3. Fold all creases of the layered vertical panels. Apply adhesive tape to one side of the small panels around the hole and adhere together firmly. Do this on all three of the layered side panels.




4. After the small panels are adhered together, they should look like this from the finished side.



Apply double-sided tape to the back side of the layered side panel and close the two sides together.




6. You should have three identical layered side panels with rubber band tabs. Apply a strip of double-sided adhesive the bottom tabs of each side.



 Attach the layered side panels to a solid hexagon.



8. All three layered side panels should be spaced as shown, with one side of the hexagon between them.



 Attach a strip of tape to one of the tabs on each of the remaining sides.



 Adhere the remaining three sides to the hexagon and slide a rubber band into the hole of each rubber band tab.



11. Slide the loose end of each rubber band into the rubber band tab of the layered side panel on its right. Do this with each rubber band until a triangle shape is formed as shown.



12. Place a strip of double-sided adhesive on the end tabs on all six of the side panels and attach them to the underside of a solid hexagon. This will be the top of the ball.
