Accessories:

Paper: Very Vanilla 12x12 cardstock (#124301), More Mustard 12x12 cardstock (#124281), Soft Suede cardstock (#115318), Early Espresso cardstock (#119686), Garden Green cardstock (#102584), Spice Cake Designer Series paper (#124003)

Inks: Crumb Cake (#121030), Pear Pizzaz (#119784), More Mustard (#103162) & Pool Party (#122938)

Misc: Sponge Daubers (#102892), Hemp (#100982), Spice Cake Designer Buttons (#124113), Holly Berry Bouquet Buttons (#125636), Dimensionals™ (#104430), Glue Dots (#103683), Scor Pal™ scoring tool (#122334), Chantilly Lace (#118480),

Cover:

5 ¾ x 12 in. More Mustard cardstock, scored at 5 ¾ and 6 ¼

3 x 5 ¾ in. Spice Cake Designer Paper (scored at 1 & 1 ½ on the 5 ¾ in. side to fold around the binding)

1 x 20 in. Spice Cake Designer Fabric (dark floral pattern)

1 x 8 inches Spice Cake Designer Fabric (light floral pattern)

Cover Greeting: 3 ¼ x 3 ¼ Very Vanilla cardstock & 3 ½ x 4 Early Espresso cardstock for 'framing', Large Spice Cake button, natural hemp, Dimensionals™

Inside: 10 1/8 x 10 1/8 in. Very Vanilla, scored at 5 1/8 on each side (quarters) and cut one side to center

Other (leaves for embellishment):

4 ¼ x 11 Very Vanilla, for stamping the leaves in Early Espresso ink, sponging and cutting out

Stamp 4 of each type leaf and sponge color in and cut each out leaving 1/8th inch

Opening panel:

One 4 ¾ x 4 ¾ Soft Suede Cardstock

One 1 x 5 inch Spice Cake Designer paper (tiny espresso and white floral print)

Flipped Down panel (pg. 2):

4 ¾ x 4 ¾ More Mustard cardstock

2 x 4 ½ inch Spice Cake Designer paper (light floral 'stripe' pattern)

Flipped Up Panel (pg. 2):

2 x 4 ¾ inch Spice Cake Designer paper (mustard floral print)

4 x 4 Soft Suede cardstock

1 x 5 inch Spice Cake Designer paper (dark floral 'stripe' pattern)

Inside Panels (pg. 3):

TWO TOP PANELS

Two 3 ¾ x 4 ½ inch Early Espresso cardstock

Two 2 x 4 ¾ inch More Mustard cardstock

Two 1 x 5 inch Spice Cake Designer paper (tiny espresso and vanilla floral print)

TWO LOWER PANELS

Two 3 x 4 ¾ inch Spice Cake Designer paper (5 petal flower print)

3 ¾ x 4 inch More Mustard cardstock

4 x 3 inch More Mustard cardstock

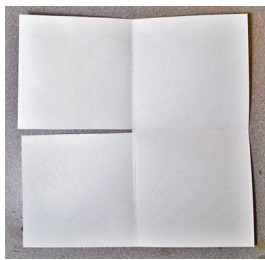
Assembly – Begin with the cover:

1. Fold the large mustard cover piece on the center score lines
2. Take the scored 3x6 designer paper and adhere it to the binding around the edge with the larger side in front
3. Take the long fabric strip and wind around and tie a knot (and place the smaller/lighter print fabric strip across the middle and tie in as well). Trim the edges.
4. Tie the 8 inch piece of lace and tie around the fabric knot
5. Stamp the greeting in Early Espresso on the vanilla cardstock and then the maple leaf in Crumb Cake (stamped off) randomly.
6. Adhere the leaves as shown and then the jumbo button with a Dimensional™.
7. Tie a bow with the hemp and glue dot it onto the button

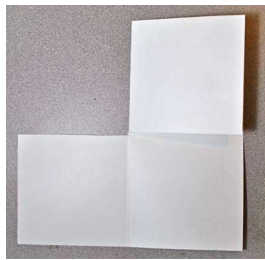


Assembly – Fig. 1 - Take the 10 1/8 inch square cardstock (scored at 5 & 5 1/8 on each side) and holding it as shown in the first figure, cut out the left side double score lines (through the middle and past the vertical double scores)

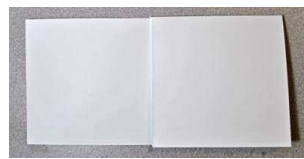
- Fold the top left panel horizontally (over the top right panel)
- Fold the (now double) top right panel down over the bottom right panel
- Fold the left panel over the 'sandwiched' right panels
- Glue this into the center of the right side 'cover'



Cut out 1/8th inch seam to the center



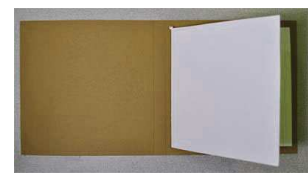
Fold top left flap to 'right' on top of right flap



Fold top right 'down' onto bottom right



Fold to 'right' like a book



Adhere inside cover centering on right side

Leaves (embellishments) – Stamp the outline leaves (3 oak leaves, 3 aspen leaves, 4 oak leaves, 3 long leaves) in Early Espresso and sponge using the sponge daubers and the More Mustard, Pear Pizzaz and Pool Party. Cut each leaf out leaving 1/8th inch all around.

INSIDE 'OPENING PANEL'



Adhere the 4 3/4 inch square of Soft Suede cardstock onto the first (closed) panel and then the 1 x 5 inch designer paper as shown on the left side.

Attach the two leaves (pre-stamped, colored and cut before beginning) with Dimensionals™ and then the button with a Dimensional™ and then tie a knot with the hemp and adhere it with a glue dot.



FLIPPED DOWN PANEL: When you open the book, the 'Flipped Down' panel will be the top the the 'sandwiched' panels. It is a $4 \frac{3}{4} \times 4 \frac{3}{4}$ More Mustard square adhere to the center and then the $2 \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ inch strip of Spice Cake designer paper. Adhere the leaf with Dimensionals and then a hemp bow with a glue dot.



FLIPPED UP PANEL: When you flip 'up' the sandwiched panels, you see the 'FLIPPED UP' panel. First adhere the $2 \times 4 \frac{3}{4}$ inch Spice Cake designer paper (mustard floral print) and then the 4×4 Soft Suede cardstock on top of that and then the 1×5 inch Spice Cake Designer paper (dark floral 'stripe' pattern). Adhere an oak leaf with Dimensionals™ and a hemp bow with a glue dot.



Inside Panels - TWO TOP PANELS

- First adhere the two 2 x 4 ¾ inch More Mustard cardstock strips as shown on each side
- Then adhere the two 3 ¾ x 4 ½ inch Early Espresso cardstock pieces as shown on each side
- Then adhere the two 1 x 5 inch Spice Cake Designer paper (tiny espresso and vanilla floral print)
- Then adhere the leaves as shown with Dimensionals™ and the button on the top left panel with a Dimensional™ and then tie a knot with the hemp and trim the edges to ¼ inch and adhere it to the center of the button with a glue dot.

TWO LOWER PANELS

- First adhere the two 3 x 4 ¾ inch Spice Cake Designer papers (5 petal flower print) as shown on each side
- Then adhere the 3 ¾ x 4 inch More Mustard cardstock as shown on the right
- Then adhere the 4 x 3 inch More Mustard cardstock
- Adhere the leaves as shown with Dimensionals™
- Adhere the green button to the right hand side layout as shown with a Dimensional™ and then tie a knot with the hemp and adhere it to the button with a glue dot
- Tie a bow with the hemp and adhere it to the left side panel with a glue dot
