

Reindeer Lineup

Set(s): Holiday Lineup, Santa's Lineup Jumbo Wheel

Accessories:

8 ¾ x 8 ½ inch Close to Cocoa cardstock
scored at 3 and 6" (on the 8 ¾ side)
3 ¾ x 2 inch Vanilla cardstock
4 x 2 ¼ inch Chocolate Chip cardstock
4 ¼ x 2 ¾ inch Riding Hood Red cardstock
Basic Black ink & Chocolate Chip ink
Crop-a-dile, Natural Hemp
2 Way Glue Pen & Dazzling Dia Glitter
Dimensionals™
Creamy Caramel marker
So Saffron marker, Real Red marker, Sahara
Sand marker, Aqua Painter,



1. On the large piece of Close to Cocoa, cut out the two corners as shown in Fig. 1
2. With the cardstock down in front of you (and the middle panel's extra panel pointing to the right), ink the jumbo roller wheel with the Chocolate Chip ink pad and wheel the entire sheet. You must re-ink after each line or you will run out of ink on a long roll!
3. Turn over to the blank side (which is the inside) and fold that extra (right square) flap in and then halfway back and punch two small holes with the Crop-a-Dile (Fig. 3). Then thread a 14 inch piece of hemp into the inside holes (see Fig. 4) and it will tie the money holder shut. If you've done it right, the bottom panel is the 2 ¾ inch panel and folds up and the top folds down to be tied shut.

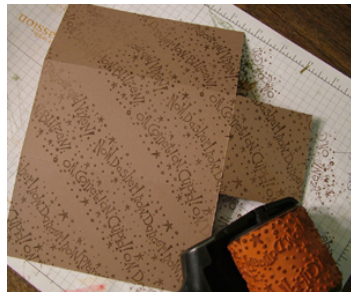

4. Stamp the reindeer image twice, once will be colored in completely and the second one, only Rudolf which you will cut out and adhere 'popped up.' I used the Caramel marker for their bodies and antlers and the Sand one for shadow around the edges, the Banana for some of the 'hair' and the red one I took some color off with an AquaPainter to make the nose not so bright.
5. Adhere that layer to the black rectangle and that layer to the red cardstock rectangle as shown (tear the red cardstock along the bottom as shown).
6. You will be adhering the layered Reindeer image to the folded down top panel towards the left hand side (because it will tie on the front on the right hand side). Add 'googly' eyes and some glitter.
