

“Holiday Lineup” Gift Card Holder

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These instructions are not for resale or redistribution.

Set(s): Holiday Lineup, Season of Joy
Accessories:

5 x 7 in. Riding Hood Red cardstock
4 ¾ x 12 in. Vanilla cardstock
scored along the 12 in. at 3”, 6” & 9”
1 x 11 strip black cardstock
1 ¾ x 3 ¾ inch. Vanilla cardstock (cover)
4 x 3 inch Kraft cardstock (cover layer)
Word Window Punch
1 ¼ inch jumbo circle punch
Basic Blank ink, Garden Green Ink, Riding Hood Red ink, Natural Hemp, Dimensionals
Earth Elements Crayons, Aquapainters
Sticky Strip, 2 way glue & glitter

1. Take the red cardstock and fold in half and stamp the cover in red ‘poinsettia’ both the large and tiny ones randomly
2. Take the long piece of scored vanilla cardstock and fold it into a “W”
3. You will be punching two “Word Window” slits in the middle (see Fig. 3) in a way that they leave an opening (so halfway in) and then punch half the circle to make a ‘finger’ opening and to open the middle that the other two punches don’t reach
4. Stamp the vanilla cardstock and allow it to dry before folding and gluing the two side flaps inside the red cover
5. Stamp the Snowmen twice in black (you will take two 2 x 4 approx.) strips of vanilla cardstock. Color one of them completely and ONLY color the focal snowman in the other and then cut it out.
6. Adhere the cut out snowman with Dimensionals™
7. Adhere the ‘lineup’ to the top center of the Kraft rectangle and then tear the bottom edge as shown
8. Wrap a length of hemp around the layered image as shown and then tie a knot and cut
9. Take the long black strip and fold it around the closed folio, leaving 1/8 of an inch on each side. Take it off and then adhere the strip shut in a circle with Sticky Strip™
10. Adhere the layered ‘lineup’ layer to the front of the ‘belly band’ you created in Step 9 with Sticky Strip.
