

# Leaf Print “Folio”

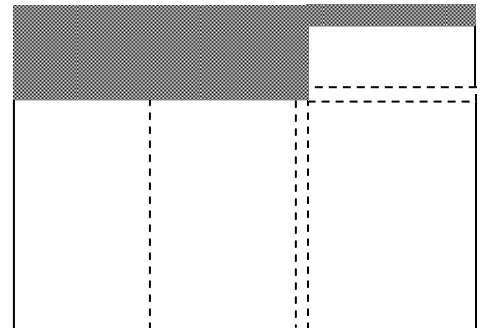


8 ½ x 11 cut to 7 ¾ x 10 ½

Held “landscape” scored at 3 3/8, 6 3/4, 7 1/8,

Held “portrait” scored at 5 3/8, 5 ¾

Cut off “gray” area



**Sets:** Autumn Leaf Prints, Fern Leaf background stamps, Words of Wisdom

**Accessories:** Sahara Sand cardstock, Vanilla cardstock, Always Artichoke cardstock and ink, Mellow Moss ink, natural hemp, slit punch, 1/8<sup>th</sup> inch hand punch, hodgepodge hardware **OTHER:** Dollar Store unlined pad 3 ½ x 5 ½ inches

1. Fold the cardstock on all of the score lines
2. Ink the Fern Leaf background stamp with the Mellow Moss ink and stamp the front cover (the back of the middle panel) and the inside far left panel (which will “fold back” and show the stamped background). Sponge the corners with the daubers in Moss ink
3. Fold the far left panel into the middle and adhere as shown, fold back the corner and adhere it with a brad. Stamp the panel as shown with “quote” and leaf.
4. **PAD:** Stamp the top “flap” as shown and tear and sponge. Adhere the pad in place and punch holes and thread the hemp and knot in place as shown

## COVER

1. On the small Vanilla rectangle, stamp one leaf as shown. Cut out a pre-stamped leaf and adhere with a Dimensional™. On the Artichoke cardstock, punch the slit on each side of the top and adhere the stamped Vanilla piece. Punch one hole on each side and thread a piece of hemp and tie
2. Tear the bottoms and sponge the edges and adhere to the front as shown
