



Stair Step Card

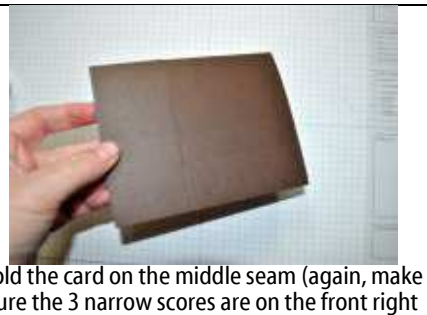
Set(s): Christmas Lodge (w: 123767, c: 123769)

Accessories:

- 5 ½ x 8 ½ Early Espresso Cardstock – scored at 2" in the 4 ¼ side
scored at 2 ¼, 4 ¼, 5 ½, 6 ½, 7 ¼ on the 5 ½ side
- 3 ½ x 4 in. Early Espresso cardstock
- 3 ¼ x 3 ¾ Whisper White cardstock
- 3 ½ x 3 Whisper White (for stamping the house 'middle' layer)
- 1 ¾ x 4 Whisper White (for left vertical panel)
- 1 x 3 ½ Glitter Paper strip # (for cutting snowflakes)
- 3 ¼ x 1 Frostwood Lodge DSP #124002 (wood grain texture)
- 2 ¾ x 1 ¾ Espresso (for punching/embossing adhering to left panel)
- 5/8 x 4 ¼ Whisper White strip (for stamping greeting)
- 2 x 6 strip of Glimmer Paper- Silver #124005 (for Sizzix snowflakes)
- Garden Green Classic Ink (#102272), Early Espresso Classic Ink (#119670)
- Decorative Label punch #120907
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue #110755, Dazzling Diamond Glitter
- Basic Rhinestones #119246 (6 large rhinestones)
- Dimensionals™ #104430
- Sizzix-----
- Vintage Wallpaper Textured Folder #120175
- Northern Frost (snowflakes) die #120901 (requires Decorative Strip Spacer Platform & Cutting Pads)
- Sizzix Big Shot, Multi-purpose platform, standard Cutting pads



Hold the card with the 2 inch score on the left side and the narrow scores on the bottom right



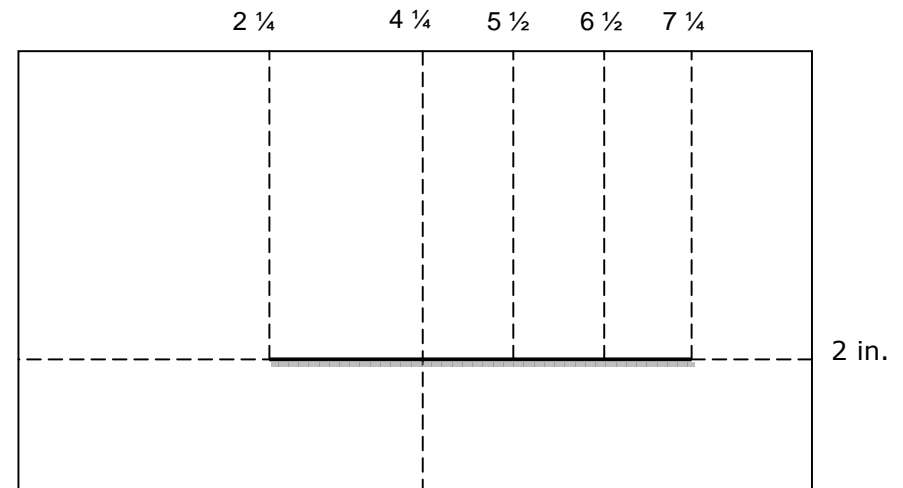
Fold the card on the middle seam (again, make sure the 3 narrow scores are on the front right)



Fold down at the first score line



Fold up at the next score line



Score on the 4 ¼ inch side at 2 inches (dotted line)
 Score on the 8 ½ inch side at 2 ¼, 4 ¼, 5 ½, 6 ½ & 7 ¼ (dotted lines)
 Cut from the 2 ¼ in. score line to the 7 ¼ inch score line (solid line above)



This is the folded



This is the finished folded card



Find the white cardstock that matches the Espresso layer—there is another that



Stamp the tree in Garden Green to the right of center



Take the Glimmer paper (pre-cut with Northern Flurries Die) and poke out the small details



Adhere one of the snowflakes and one of the rhinestones as shown



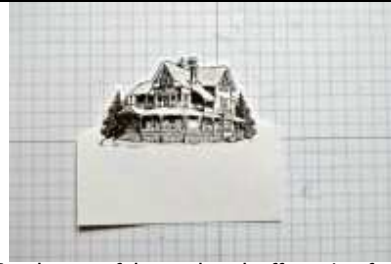
Adhere the stamped layer to the coordinating Espresso layer



Adhere that layer to the back fold of the 3D card



On the 3 1/2 x 3 white cardstock held 'landscape' stamp the house at the top



Cut the top of the cardstock off starting from the middle of the house



Take the Glimmer paper strip and cut a gentle slope off the top



Adhere the Glimmer paper under the House



Cut off the extra strip of white under the Glimmer paper



Adhere the house to the middle layer



Adhere the strip of designer paper to the Front layer as shown



Take the strip of white cardstock and emboss it with the Vintage Wallpaper



Adhere the embossed cardstock to the left panel as shown



Punch out the small Espresso rectangle with the Vintage Label punch



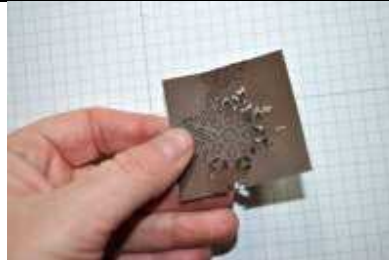
Emboss the label with the same Embossing folder



Viola!



Add Dimensionals to the back



Poke out the pre-cut snowflake (cut with the Sizzix 'Northern Flurry' die)



Adhere the brown snowflake and Embossed layer as shown on left panel



Add another sparkly snowflake



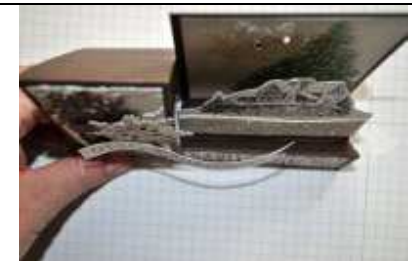
Stamp the greeting on the narrow strip of white



Cut the right edge like a 'V'



Bend and adhere the greeting to the front



This is a top view of the greeting



Add the rhinestones



Use the SU Multipurpose Glue for the snow (this glue is white and dimensional...!)



Sprinkle on glitter and tap off excess



MISSING: 3rd snowflake (see big sample)











Winter Blue

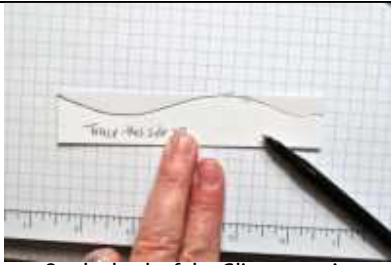
Inspired from a card by Melany Watson

Set(s): Christmas Lodge (w: 123767, c: 123769)
 Lovely As a Tree (w #115026)

Accessories:

- 5 ½ x 8 ½ Night of Navy cardstock
- 2 ½ x 5 inches Whisper White cardstock (for stamping house/trees)
- 2 ½ x 5 inches Whisper White cardstock (for stamping greeting/tearing layer)
- 1 x 5 inch Glimmer Paper- Silver #124005
- 1/8th inch x 5 inches - Glimmer Paper- Silver #124005
- Night of Navy Ink
- 2 Way Glue & Dazzling Diamonds Glitter

 <p>On one of the white cardstock strips Stamp the house in the top middle</p>	 <p>Stamp the trees on either side</p>	 <p>You have this</p>	 <p>Fold the navy cardstock in half and hold it 'landscape'</p>
 <p>Adhere the stamped layer at the top</p>	 <p>On the other white strip of cardstock, Stamp the greeting</p>	 <p>Tear the greeting as shown</p>	 <p>Flip over the top torn white piece and adhere it like a snowbank</p>



On the back of the Glimmer strip
trace the wave form provided



Cut the Glimmer paper in the wave



Finished wave



Lay the Glimmer strip down like a snowbank



Adhere the greeting to the bottom



Adhere the narrow strip of Glimmer paper
to the bottom



Carefully add 2 way glue and glitter
Try not to touch the blue outlines or the ink
Will run



Card/Gift Bag Set

Set(s): Christmas Lodge (w: 123767, c: 123769)

Accessories:

To make the bag:

(Two) 5 ½ x 8 ½ in. Cherry Cobbler cardstock pieces
 5 ¼ x 4 ¼ Whisper White cardstock
 2 x 8 ½ inches Whisper White cardstock (for cutting Sizzix snowflakes)
 2 x 5 ½ inches Cherry Cobbler cardstock (for punching the Lace border)
 4 x 6 Cellophane Bag (#102757)
 Extra Large Oval punch (#119859)
 Lace Ribbon Border Punch (#122362)
 5/8th in. Satin Ribbon – 19 inches
 OTHER: white sandwich bag (cut down to 6" high)

To Make the Card:

7 ½ x 5 ½ in. Chocolate Chip Cardstock
 3 ½ x 3 in. Frostwood Lodge Designer Paper, #124002 (red plaid)
 2 ½ x 3 ½ Whisper White cardstock (for card top)
 1 ½ x 2 ½ Chocolate Chip (for punching/pressing)
 3 1/8 x 2 Whisper White (for stamping house)
 3 ¼ x 2 1/8 Chocolate Chip (for framing house image)
 Decorative Label punch (#120907)
 4 inches Cherry Cobbler Quilted Satin Ribbon (#124105)
 Winter Wishes Stitched Felts, mittens (#124108)
 Dimensionals (#140430), Sticky Strip (#104294), Hemp Twine-Natural #100982

-----Sizzix-----

Finial Press Textured Folder #115963
 Northern Frost (snowflakes) die #120901 (requires Decorative Strip Spacer Platform & Cutting Pads)
 Sizzix Big Shot, Multi-purpose platform, standard Cutting pads (Comes as a set #113439)



The white bag was pre-cut to 6" high



Fold down the bottom flap



Put a 2" piece of Sticky Strip™ on each corner
 And peel away the pink cover



Adhere it to the bottom of one of the large red
 Pieces of cardstock



Adhere 2 inch pieces of Sticky Strip™ in each corner and peel off pink cover



Adhere the second side... this is your Result



Punch the Extra Large Oval on the Center top on one side



Punch the second side through The first side



This is what you should have



Take the large piece of Whisper White Cardstock and place it in the embossing folder



Run it through the Sizzix to Emboss



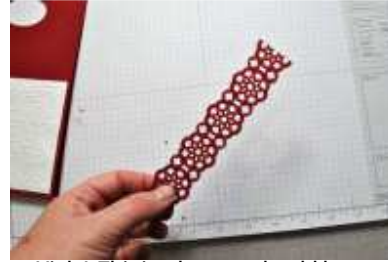
Adhere the embossed layer to the Bottom of the front bag



Punch the Lace Border punch



This is a particularly difficult punch to Work with... press down HARD



Viola! This is what you should have



Adhere it to the front as shown



Run the 2 x 8 ½ inch strip of white through the Sizzix with the 'Northern Frost' die



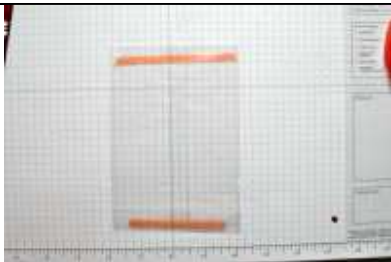
Luckily... I have pre-cut these for you at the Stamp Festival



You just need to use the important pokey tool (aka toothpick) to push out the details on the flakes



Adhere three of the flakes to the top Of the bag on the red as shown



Take the clear flat bag and adhere Sticky Strip™ on the back (the side with the vertical seam)



Peel off the pink cover to the Sticky Strip™ And adhere the clear bag to the front



Add rhinestones to the snowflakes



Make the Card: Fold the Chocolate Chip cardstock in half



Adhere the Designer paper to the bottom Of the card



Emboss the larger white layer in the Sizzix



Adhere the white embossed layer to the front



Stamp the house on the small white rectangle



Adhere the white cardstock to the Coordinating Choc. Chip cardstock



Take the smallest piece of Choc. Chip cardstock and punch it With the Vintage Label punch



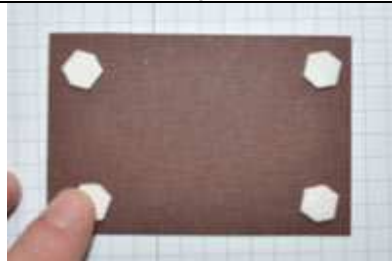
Emboss the punched piece



Cut the embossed and punched Label cardstock horizontally as shown



Adhere the Cherry Ribon horizontally as shown And the two pieces of the punched Choc. Cardstock



Put Dimensionals™ in each corner Of the focal stamped image



Adhere the focal image to the front as Shown



Adhere the button as shown



Tie a knot with the hemp and cut it



Glue dot the hemp to the button... YES... I Totally CHEAT. If you want to thread it through and tie a knot... GO FOR IT.



Add 2-Way Glue to the rooftop and snowy Areas of the stamped image. Be careful of Not touching the stamped image (it will bleed)



Dust the image with Dazzling Diamonds And tap off the excess



Slip the card in the clear bag



Using a glue dot, adhere the mittens to the front top right by a point in the string that is just off center



Tie a ribbon with the white satin and Make a bow



Adhere the bow on top of the mittens at the point they are adhered to the bag











Homespun Holiday Card

Set(s): Christmas Lodge (w: 123767, c: 123769); Petite Pairs (w: 122495, c: 122497)

Accessories:

- 8 1/2 x 5 1/2 Always Artichoke cardstock
- 5 1/4 x 4 inch Crumb Cake cardstock
- 3 1/4 x 4 1/4 Always Artichoke cardstock
- 2 7/8 x 3 7/8 Cherry Cobbler cardstock
- 2 3/4 x 3 3/4 Very Vanilla cardstock
- 2 x 2 in. Very Vanilla cardstock (for stamping & punching greeting)
- 2 x 5 in. Cherry Cobbler cardstock (for punching)
- Linen Thread (15 inches) #104199
- Curly Label Punch #119851
- Large Oval Punch #119855
- Always Artichoke Classic Ink
- Cherry Cobbler Classic Ink
- 12 inches Chantilly Lace Crochet Trim #118480

 <p>Fold the Artichoke cardstock in half</p>	 <p>Take the Crumb Cake cardstock</p>	 <p>Adhere the embossed layer to the front</p>	 <p>Adhere the Artichoke layer to the front</p>
 <p>In the tree in Artichoke ink</p>	 <p>Stamp it left of center as shown</p>	 <p>Adhere the stamped layer to the Cherry frame layer</p>	 <p>Stamp the holiday greeting in Cherry Cobbler</p>

 <p>Stamp the branch and birds in Artichoke ink</p>	 <p>Punch out the greeting, catching the edges of the branch in the oval</p>	 <p>Punch the cherry square with the curly Label punch</p>	 <p>Cut the punched image in half</p>
 <p>Adhere the two halves together but a little Closer together</p>	 <p>Affix a Dimensional to the piece</p>	 <p>Adhere the oval punched greeting</p>	 <p>Tie the linen thread around the layered Tree image and tie a bow</p>
 <p>Adhere Dimensionals™ to the back of the Layered piece</p>	 <p>Adhere the layered greeting to the front Of the card as shown</p>	 <p>Affix Dimensionals™ to each corner</p>	 <p>Adhere the layer to the center front on Top of the Artichoke layer</p>
 <p>Add the strip of crochet lace ribbon at The bottom of the layered image With Sticky Strip™</p>
