

# Wedding Box

**Set(s):** Leaves A La Carte jumbo wheel,  
Carte Postale, Together Forever  
**Accessories:**

One 8 ½ x 11 sheet Sahara Sand cardstock  
 Scored on 11 in. side at 2,5,7,10  
 Scored on 8 ½ in side at 2 in & 7 in  
 (see figure below for scoring and cutting)  
 Strips of Sahara Sand cardstock for stamped  
 images (to be punched out)  
 Strips of Artichoke c/s (punching ½ in. circles)  
 Scallop Circle punch  
 1 ¼ Jumbo Circle punch  
 1 ⅜ Jumbo Circle punch  
 ½ inch circle (for faux scallop)  
 Moss taffeta ribbon, Artichoke ink pad  
 Jumbo roller handle with Almost Artichoke ink  
 Glue dots, Sponge Daubers, OTHER: rhinestones  
 Velcro™ circles



1. Roller wheel the entire sheet of cardstock and then cut out the 'grey' areas in diagram below. (You will be cutting out along the 3 inch panel, all but one 3 x 3 inch tab. On the other side you will be ONLY cutting out one 2 x 2 inch tab.
2. Fold on all the pre-scored lines and cut the solid lines (that will make the tabs for the bottom of the box). Assemble the box as shown, tucking in the sides at the top and folding over the flap.
3. Punch out about eight ½ inch circles in Artichoke and adhere them to the inside of the front flap, overlapping to appear to be scallops (see bottom fig.)
4. Sponge all the edges of the box
5. Stamp the circular stamp in Artichoke ink on a strip of Sahara Sand and punch out with Scallop Circle punch and sponge edges
6. Stamp the emblem stamp on Sahara Sand and punch out the middle flower with the 1 ¼ inch Jumbo circle punch and then layer with an Artichoke circle (punched with 1 ⅜ inch punch. Layer that onto Step 5's layer with a Dimensional. Add a rhinestone
7. Adhere the layered emblem onto the box front (gluing half, leaving overlap)
8. Tie a moss taffeta bow and adhere with a glue dot
9. Optional (Velcro circles): Adhere Velcro circles for easy open/close
